

## **RCR / BSHNI Travelling Professorship 2022/23**

### **Background:**

This visiting Professorship is jointly funded by the RCR and BSHNI to highlight the role of head and neck imaging within the UK.

### **Nature:**

The visiting professor will be expected to undertake 6-8 visits to training programmes, over a period of 12 months (starting in September 2022), to deliver lectures and undertake appropriate workshops or small group teaching as part of each visit. One lecture will be recorded and made available online, which can be delivered as a webinar.

The purpose of the visits is educational: to raise the profile of head and neck imaging amongst trainees, to highlight the rewards of a career in head and neck radiology, and to foster high quality head and neck imaging throughout the UK. Applications are invited from experienced head and neck radiologists who can provide valuable insights into day-to-day head and neck imaging practice as well as those who have a particular field of expertise or academic research.

At the end of the professorship, the successful candidate will be required to deliver a lecture at the next BSHNI annual meeting.

### **Funding:**

Up to £5,000

### **Eligibility:**

The professorship is open to head and neck radiologists who are Fellows of the RCR in good standing, members of the BSHNI, resident in the United Kingdom and in active clinical practice at the time of the application and the award/visits.

### **To apply:**

Candidates should submit; a current curriculum vitae; a 200-400 word description of the applicant's teaching record and a description of why they would be suitable for the professorship; and a list of proposed workshop/lecture titles suitable for presentation to the training programmes.

An Appointments Board combined of members of the Royal College of Radiologists and the British Society of Head & Neck Imaging will consider applications. The decision of the Appointments Board is final and binding, applicants will be informed of the outcome as soon as possible after the decision has been approved.
